The project consists of ducted units, cassette units and floor standing units. The power consumption of the originally specified Electric VRF System was too great for the incoming power available, therefore we proposed the **Panasonic** Gas Fired System. The GHP system operates on single phase power supply, with improved efficiencies and reduced running costs.

We are delighted to be involved in delivering this air conditioning solution in what will be an iconic building in the heart of Dublin. The new Victoria's Secret Store on Grafton Street opened on the 5th of December 2017.



PROJECT

Panasonic Gas-Fired Heat Pumps are very specialised systems which are used to power the indoor air con units in locations where the electrical power on site is not sufficient to cater for the loads or where CO2 emissions must be reduced. GHP systems also enable the buildings electrical power supply to be used for other critical electrical demands, and reduces or eliminates potential capital cost to upgrade power substations to run standard electric VRF systems.
