PROJECT

Lidl were delighted to announce the expansion of Mullingar Distribution Centre at Robinstown, Co. Westmeath – a €75 million project that will support at least 1,200 construction jobs during the development phase. The extension will be built by main contractor John Sisk & Son.

The new development at Robinstown, Mullingar has increased the existing Lidl facility's capacity to 62,000m² and is now one of the largest buildings in the country. The extended facility will house the largest solar array of Lidl's properties across Ireland, providing enough energy to meet approximately 25% of the plant's energy requirements.
